At The-Zone! we have tea, coffee, juice and biscuits but donations of supplies are always welcomed.

Parents/carers remain responsible for their children at all of our sessions & events!

Zone-In! sessions

This is the new name for all sessions we hold at The-Zone! We hope that this will make it easier for families to know what to expect. All of our indoor equipment; games consoles (XboxOne, PS4, PS3, Wii's, Xbox360, handheld games; PSPs, DSIs. 3DSs) laptops, Ipads, Android tablets, arts & crafts and beads, Lego, Duplo, wooden train track and HappyLand sets (and probably more too!) We have plenty of tea, coffee, juice and biscuits.

Saturday Zone

Formerly Cyber Zone, on alternate Saturdays 10.30am - 2.30pm (NOT during the Summer holidays!) Check out the calender pages for the dates. The cost is £2.50 per child and you are very welcome to bring along a packed lunch and stay for the whole session.

After School Zone

Every Wednesday and Thursday after school during term-time, join us from 3 - 6pm. The cost is £2 per child.

Fun Zone

Every Wednesday during school holidays, 10.30am—2.30pm. The cost will be £2.50 per child and you're are welcome to bring a packed lunch with you. If the weather is nice we will have the outdoor space with the outdoor toys, a bouncy castle, go-karts & trikers too.

Coffee Zone! for parents

Our drop-in coffee sessions will be held every other week and are for you to come along to at any point and have a coffee, chat and take a look at the branch library. You can stay for as long or short a time as you like. There's always plenty of biscuits! Pre-schoolers are always welcome - there's usually a couple of babies/toddlers there each time.

If you need help with DLA forms or other paper work bring them along with you.

Rules @ The-Zone!

Our aim is to support local people with autism and their families. As parents and carers of people with autism, we volunteer our time to ensure that this support reaches the local families of Hart, Rushmoor and some of the surrounding areas. To help ensure that everyone gets the most from our activities, we would appreciate it if you would read and comply with the following:

What you can expect from The-Zone! Volunteers -

- They will follow The-Zone! policies and procedures and fairly represent the charity.
- They will do all they can to create a safe & welcoming environment for all those attending The-Zone! events.
- They will treat all other volunteers and members with respect. Any physical, emotional, verbal abuse or rudeness towards other volunteers or members will not be tolerated.
- They will maintain confidentiality regarding The-Zone! volunteers, members and its work.
- They will be reliable. They will make it clear when and how they will be available and meet these expectations, or provide as much notice as possible if they cannot.
- They will respond to queries within agreed time limits.
- They will listen to all member concerns and respond appropriately.

In return, we ask that all members -

- Treat all volunteers and members with respect. Any physical, emotional, verbal abuse or rudeness towards volunteers or other members will not be tolerated.
- Treat all property (including the venues we use) with respect and not deliberately damage anything.
- Communicate with The-Zone! volunteers. We ask that you tell us if you have any concerns and respond to our questions or queries within the agreed time limits. This includes ensuring that you pre-book for all events and telling us how and when you will cover the cost (if there is one).
- Supervise and be responsible for their children at all times. As a result, you must do all you can to ensure that your children also follow this code of conduct.
- Pay in advance for events when booking places (for Zone-In! activities it is fine to pay on the day.)
 We can accept any of the following:

Bocketts Farm, Leatherhead (KT22 9BS) - with transport option

We're off to the farm for a family fun day on Sunday 27th July. As well as the animals, there's tractor trailer rides, donkey rides, a giant air pillow to bounce on, trampolines, outdoor play areas (including a new water balloon fight area, so bring a change of clothes!) indoor soft play - it's fantastic fun! As it's out of our area, we will be organising a coach too. Places will cost £6 per child (those under 2yrs are free) and if you require seats on the coach they will be £2.50 per person. The coach will leave Samuel Cody (GU14 8SS) at 9.30am to arrive at the farm at 10.30am. We will then leave the farm at 3pm to get back to Samuel Cody at 4pm.

We will have the upstairs studio for our group and you can chose from the "party" shelves which ceramic you'd like to decorate. The cost is £6 per item painted. Teen Zone-In!

These sessions are especially for those aged 11 years and over who want to come along and socialise with those who are a similar age. On one Friday each month, 6 - 8pm we will have all the Zone-In equipment, as well as the Hexbugs and a tuck shop too! You may bring 12+ rated games but they must be approved by a committee member FIRST. The cost will be £2 per child & money for the tuck shop. Parents need to stay at these sessions but it's a great opportunity to talk to others who understand life with a teen on the spectrum. If there are specific games or equipment your teen would like us to purchase, let us know.

At our June session, we are planning on tie-dying The-Zone! t-shirts (so dress for mess!) - each ASD Teen can have 2 t-shirts to personalise (additional shirts are £2 each)

Teen Zone-Out!

These outings are a great opportunity for our 11 years and over members to socialise and be active together!

For the time being, we can only run self-funding Teen Zone-Out! events until we have found some grants towards the cost of the outings.

Boardmaker software contains thousands of pictures and symbols that can be used to build symbol based materials like daily time-tables, feelings boards and social stories. Boardmaker is installed on 12 library computers including in Aldershot, Farnborough and Fleet. Every library with Boardmaker has a printer and laminator available so parents/carers can print and laminate their boards. There is no charge for using this but you do need to book a session. Paperwork must be on headed paper which includes the organisations logo from an official source and have the child's full name, the child's date of birth, the child's medical condition or diagnosis or proof of foster care. You can now renew your tax credit claim online. Once you have received your annual tax credit review forms, you can then respond online rather than by post or telephone, but only if you have no changes to report.

The National Key Scheme (NKS) offers disabled people independent access to locked public toilets around the country. Toilets fitted with NKS locks can now be found in shopping centres, pubs, cafés, department stores, bus and train stations and many other locations in most parts of the country.




